Students observe that by increasing the mass and velocity, the time taken for the marble to stop moving is increasing.

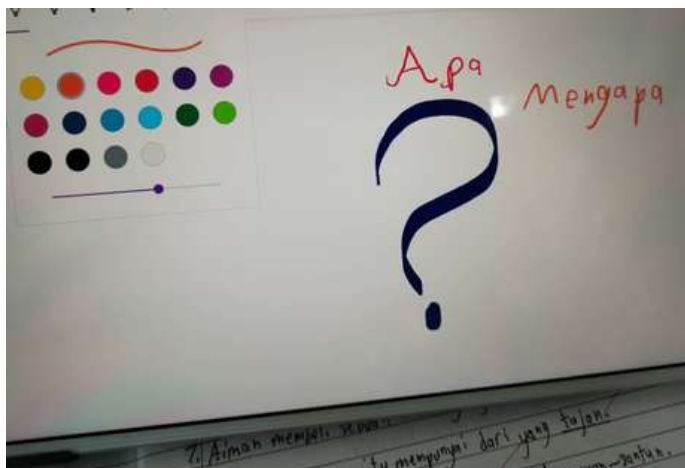
